Since 2007, Access Allies of Bloomington-Normal (AABN) has held an annual "Parenting and Disabilities Expo," a free event showcasing agencies, businesses, and other services of use to people with disabilities of all ages. During the same period, the Transition Planning Committee (TPC) has held their own "Transition Expo" aimed towards students with disabilities preparing to transition out of high school.

This year, on October 20, 2009, AABN is joining forces with TPC to hold our first combined AABN/TPC Annual "Parenting and Disabilities Expo" on Tuesday, October 20 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Bloomington High School's Student Center!
